

OCTOBER 2, 2017 MILLCREEK-RICHLAND JOINT AUTHORITY MEETING

Millcreek-Richland Joint Authority meeting of October 2, 2017 was brought to order by John Wolgemuth.

Members present were: Lucas Blakeslee, Jan Klaus, Rebecca Schnoke, John Wolgemuth, Hubert Risser (absent) and Maybelle Morgan.

Secretary's report was read. A change was made to pump at #5 station "measured" should be "meggered". A motion was made to approve the secretary's report by Lucas Blakeslee and seconded by Rebecca Schnoke.

Treasurer's report was read. A motion was made by Jan Klaus to pay for all August bills marked with an asterisk and seconded by John Wolgemuth, all in favor. George Savage was at this meeting asking if there would be any problems or if he needed another EDU to put a laundry matt in the room next to the bar/restaurant (previously was the ice cream shop). After a discussion, it was decided that the sewer authority does not see any problems and he does not need another EDU. This property is already marked as commercial and if the Richland Borough and Richland Borough Water says okay it is alright with us.

Henry Eberly advised the manhole on Park St. in Newmanstown has been installed.

Henry pulled #2 pump at #5 station which was the pump that meggered high and they repaired it and then put it back in and now is working fine. Within the next couple of weeks they are going to pull the other one that had the impeller problem.

On Monday, September 25, 2017 Klien's came to vac the grit chamber and it really was not that bad. Then they went to clean #5 out and that had a five gallon bucket.

On Tuesday, September 26, 2017 Power Systems came and did all the checks on all the generators, only found a few little things wrong.

Henry asked if he would be able to attend a seminar on October 3, 2017 at Danica Consulting & Training Services, LLC for "wastewater security" at the cost of \$240.00. Authority said it was okay since it was replacing a seminar he was to attend on October 27, 2017.

Henry wanted to know who to get to clean the furnace. Suggestions were Art Honeycut, Wentling, Weiler or Ray Moyer. Henry said he will make some calls and see who he can get.
